
## Parking Suggestions:

#### Route 1:

Take 101 North, exit Whipple Avenue.

Turn left on to **Whipple Avenue**.

Turn left on to Veterans Boulevard.

Turn right on to Middlefield Road.

Turn right on to **Broadway**.

#### Route 2:

Take El Camino Real North.

Turn right on to Jefferson Avenue.

Turn left on to Broadway.

#### Route 3:

Take 280 North, exit Farm Hill Boulevard.

Go forward on to Jefferson Avenue.

Turn left on to Broadway.

#### **Coming from San Francisco:**

#### Route 1:

Take 101 South, exit Whipple Avenue.

Go forward on to Veterans Boulevard.

Turn right on to Middlefield Road.

Turn right on to **Broadway**.

#### Route 2:

Take El Camino Real South.

Turn left on to Jefferson Avenue.

Turn left on to **Broadway**.

#### Route 3:

Take 280 South, exit Farm Hill Boulevard.

Turn left on to Farm Hill Boulevard.

Go forward on to Jefferson Avenue.

Turn left on to Broadway.
