Bird Rattle

Background:

In Mexico, rattles are popular during New Year's celebrations. They are shaken to welcome the generous spirits of the new year and to drive away the unhappy spirits of past years.

Directions:

- 1. Cut out two circle templates. Cover one end of your toilet paper roll with one circle and cover with masking tape.
- 2. Tape a craft stick into the other end of the roll.
- 3. Place some beans inside the roll.
- 4. Cover the end with the other circle and cover with masking tape.
- 5. Color the pieces of your bird rattle decoration.
- 6. Glue the large rectangular piece around the entire toilet paper roll. Then, glue the smaller rectangular piece around the bottom of the roll.
- 7. Finish your rattle by gluing on the beak, eyes and feathers.
