Background:

In the 19th century the development of the railways enabled circuses to travel across the country. By 1870, the Southern Pacific Railroad operated the California railroad.

Directions:

- 1. Color the Southern Pacific passenger car and wheels.
- 2. Cut along the outside edge of the car.
- 3. Fold along the dotted lines. Tape the tabs inside the car.
- 4. Cut the wheels. Fold the wheels along the dotted lines.
- 6. Tape the wheels to the bottom of the passenger car.
- 7. Cut out the pictures of the circus performers and animals.
- 8. Glue the pictures to the windows of the passenger car.
