

# Trains

## Background:

In the 19th century the development of the railways enabled circuses to travel across the country. By 1870, the Southern Pacific Railroad operated the California railroad.

## Directions:

1. Color the Southern Pacific passenger car and wheels.
2. Cut along the outside edge of the car.
3. Fold along the dotted lines. Tape the tabs inside the car.
4. Cut the wheels. Fold the wheels along the dotted lines.
6. Tape the wheels to the bottom of the passenger car.
7. Cut out the pictures of the circus performers and animals.
8. Glue the pictures to the windows of the passenger car.
